

International Summer School

The **Summer School 2009** is an international and interdisciplinary project presented by the HafenCity Universität professorships "Urban Design and Neighbourhood Planning" and "Urban Design". Thematically and in terms of content, the Summer School will take place in the context of the project **Neighbourhood University UdN**, a research and education initiative created by the HCU in cooperation with the **International Building Exhibition (IBA) Hamburg 2013** and the **Kampnagel Culture Factory**.

The **UdN** is a temporary and residual conversion of the former Local Health Authority Wilhelmsburg, which concerns itself with the experimental development of contemporary, novel forms of education between culture and science.

The **Summer School** will place the **Neighbourhood University** in an international context. Against the background of Wilhelmsburg's diverse cultures and ways of life, the international Summer School takes on the character of an experiment: how will we learn, work and live together on the construction site?

The **production of scientific knowledge** will be combined with the issue of **intercultural coexistence** as the borders between professions, languages and cultures dissolve. For two weeks, participating students will explore the free space of an evolving **architecture of possibility** in the scale of 1:1 and reflect upon their experiences in the context of urban development and globalization.

Invitees include universities located in some of the Wilhelmsburg immigrant population's countries of origin like Turkey, Italy, Spain, Poland, Russia, Portugal, Bulgaria, Rumania, as well as universities in Hamburg's sister cities. Participants may include students of urban planning, urban design, architecture, art, geography and civil engineering.
